The U.S. Embassy in Manila will have limited services and no routine consular appointments on June 30, 2022. Regular operations will resume on Friday, July 1, 2022, following the inauguration of President-elect Ferdinand Marcos Jr. at the National Museum of the Philippines. There will be inauguration-related road closures and checkpoints near the embassy, and in other areas of Manila throughout the week that are posted on the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority website. Motorists should consider alternative routes during this period.
