US ARMY RECRUITING VISIT 17 JULY

Prequalification Requirements:

1. Age: 17 – 34 years old (up to 39 years of age with waiver)
2. Medical history: Meet Army height and weight requirements, no disqualifying medical conditions, meet Army piercing and tattoo standards.
3. Moral history: Cannot be undergoing any civil convictions or certain law violations, as some may disqualify you from enlisting.
4. Education: High school seniors, graduate, or have equivalent education credentials.
5. Marital status: Single or Married with two or less children (if more than two children, dependency waiver is required)
6. Citizenship: Must be a I-551 holder (Green Card) or US citizen.

Required Documents to bring:

1. US Passport or I-551 Card w/foreign passport.
2. SSN Card
3. Birth certificate/Born Abroad certificate, Naturalization certificate.
4. High school/College transcripts and diploma, or other education credentials (GED)
5. If Married, Marriage certificate w/dependents ID, SSN cards and birth certificate.
